They would like to feedback to GPs what students enjoy about placements TEC and Ministry of Education meeting - power of TI grant lies with MoE. - presented them with increase of TI grant which was declined due to that many other health professionals are structling and
		due to that many other health professionals are struggling and there is equity concern. They are looking into TI grant and hoping it will shift into TWO domain - Can't commit to date for review of TI grant - "Maybe" response for undergrads accessing the TI grant as a lump sum. Concerned that "students will spend it all at once" - Overall opinion that TI grant is probably enough because "students aren't dropping out in droves" - Universities will be contacted by the TEC in coming weeks to ask about feasibilities of administering a lump sum to all students.
